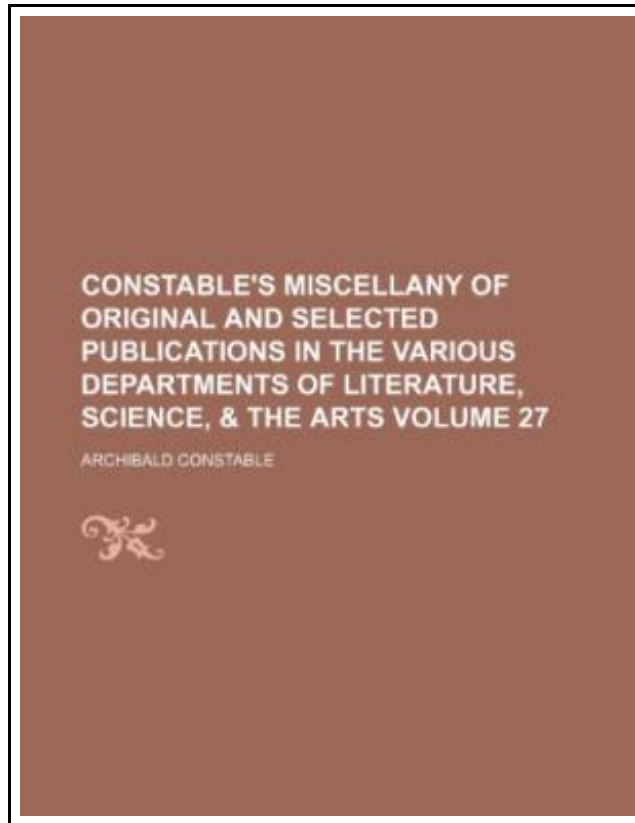

If, therefore, a retreat were actually resolved upon as absolutely necessary, he thought the army should only fall back upon Galicia, and the strong country about Astorga. But he said, in his reply to the General, that Leon and the two Castiles (with the exception of La Mancha and the city of Madrid) were the provinces least distinguished for a military, patriotic, or provincial spirit, in all Spain: the people had been passive during the late events, and had seen their country occupied successively by the strongest party, and that it was even difficult to blame them; for, living in open villages, in vast plains, destitute both of arms and of horses, they had neither the means of defence nor escape. That such a country must of necessity belong to the party which was superior in cavalry: still, that even there a right feeling was not wanting; the towns were abandoned at the approach of the enemy; not a single magistrate had been brought over to take the oath of allegiance to the intruder, nor had the French been able to enlist a single soldier. The other provinces were possessed by the most ardent and determined spirit. There was no doubt of the people. The government was new, and had hitherto been too numerous to be very active, but there was hope that that inconvenience would be soon remedied. They are resolute, added Mr Frere, and I believe...
