Pursuant to a congressional request, GAO reviewed the military services fiscal year (FY) 1991 budget requests for ammunition items and the Army s request for ammunition production base support. GAO found that the: (1) services did not justify \$424 million of their \$2.2-billion FY 1991 ammunition requests; (2) Army overstated its \$1.2-billion FY 1991 request by \$343.3 million; (3) Army adequately supported its request for modernizing and expanding the ammunition production base; (4) Army did not need \$88,000 of its FY 1989 appropriation and \$48.9 million of its FY 1990 appropriation, since it decided not to buy two items; (5) Navy overstated \$19.6 million of its \$345.7-million FY 1991 budget request and did not need \$1 million of its FY 1990 appropriation due to an item s reduced unit cost; (6) Air Force overstated its \$417.6-million FY 1991 request by \$62.6 million; and (7) Marine Corps did not need \$8.5 million of its \$284.7-million FY 1991 request, but could use \$2.3 million of the unneeded funds to procure two items that were in short supply.
